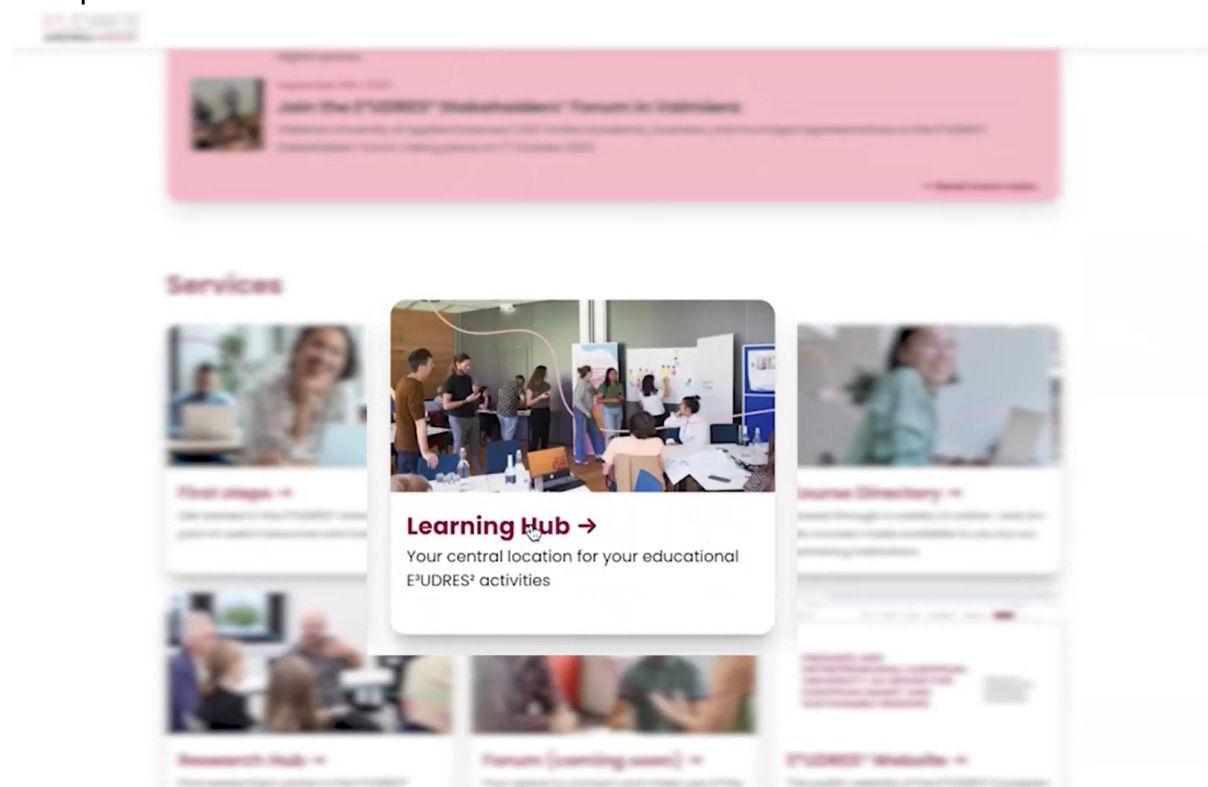


How to use the E³UDRES² Learning Hub basic level | log in tutorial



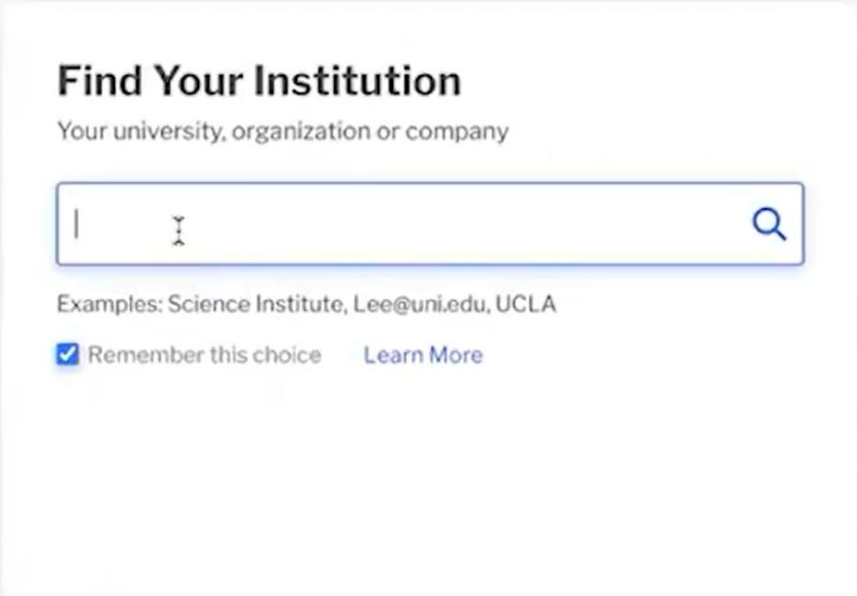
Welcome to the Arena, the online, digital platform for the E³UDRES² European Universities Alliance.



To access the learning hub you can go directly to
<https://arena.eudres.eu/learning/>.

If you are a student or an academic from one of the E³UDRES² universities, you can log in by using your own university account, then account you use to access your university email and other services.

For this, we use the Edugain service and here you will need to search for your university, like in my case the Politehnica of Timisoara.

At the first login, please complete the minimum required information, like your country, in my case Romania. Select your time zones because like that all the meetings and all the information will be correctly displayed to you...

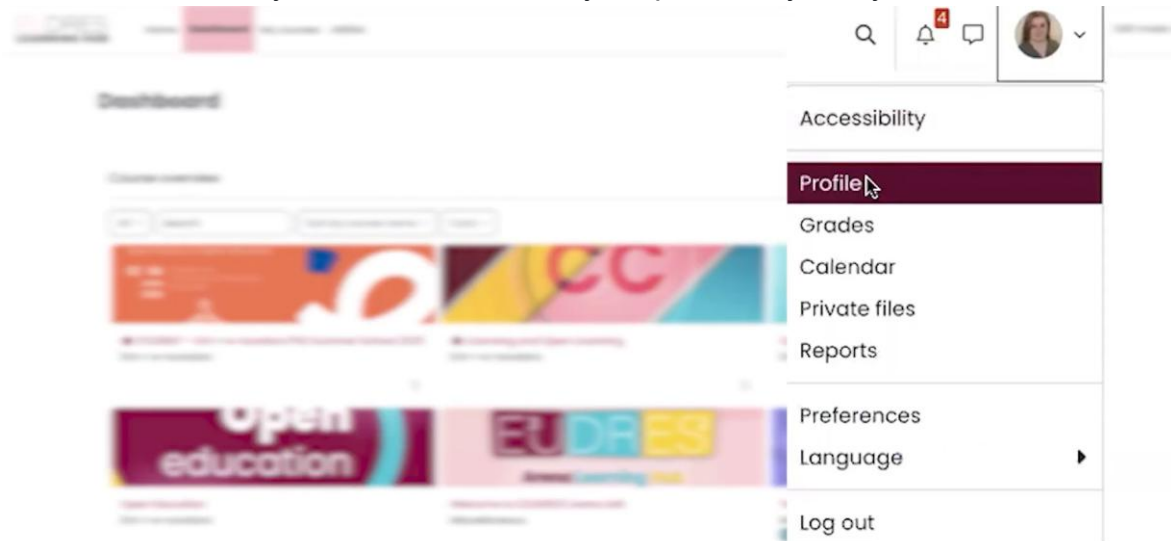
...and then choose from which university you are coming, your primary role in that university, your gender because we need this for European data and if you want your age and your level of education, also if you are a full-time a professor or a student.

Update your profile.

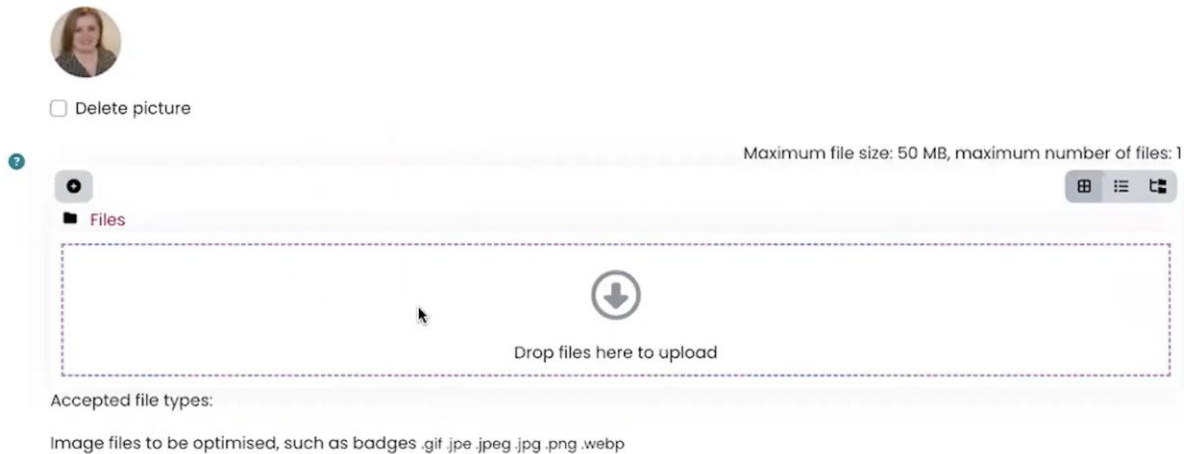

From your profile you can always access your calendar.

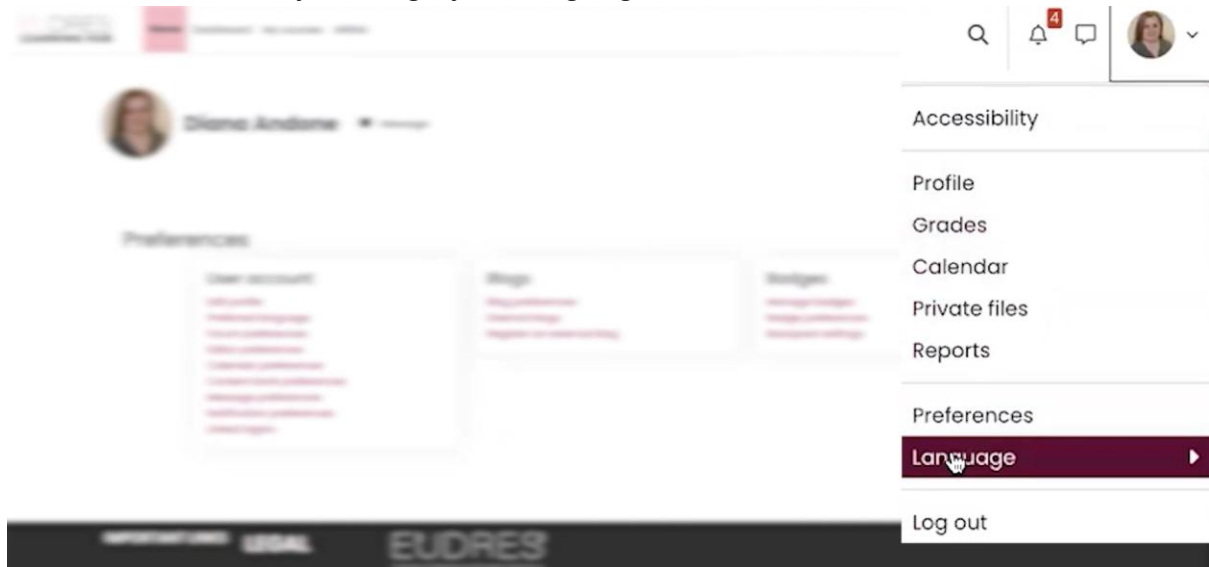

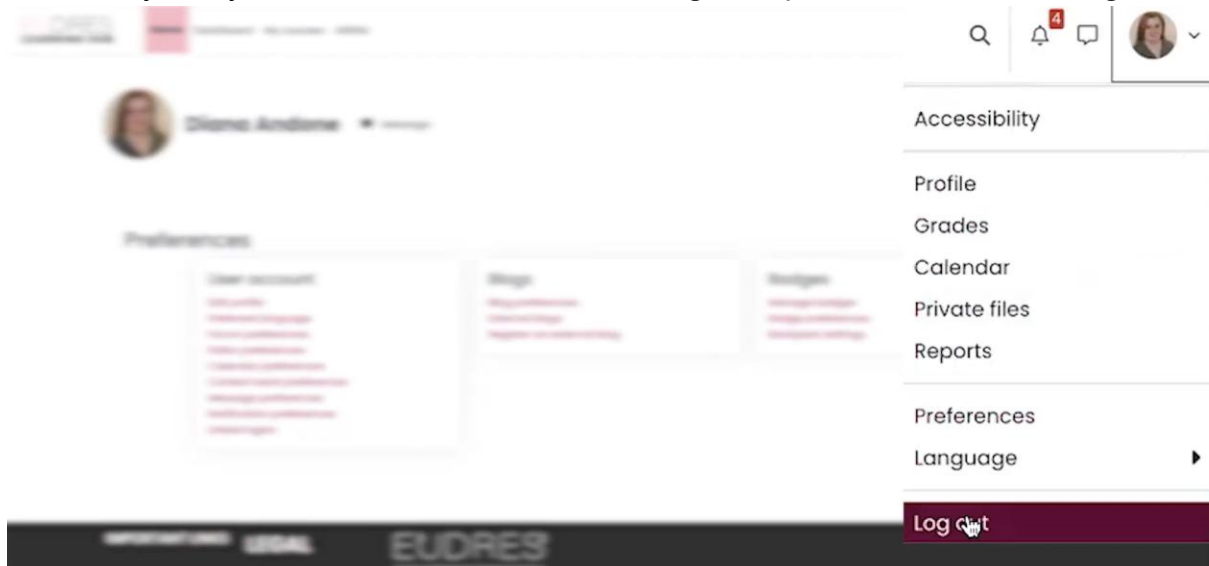
You can always access your preferences where you can change how you will receive your messages, your emails and all of the other information coming from the E³UDRES² learning hub.

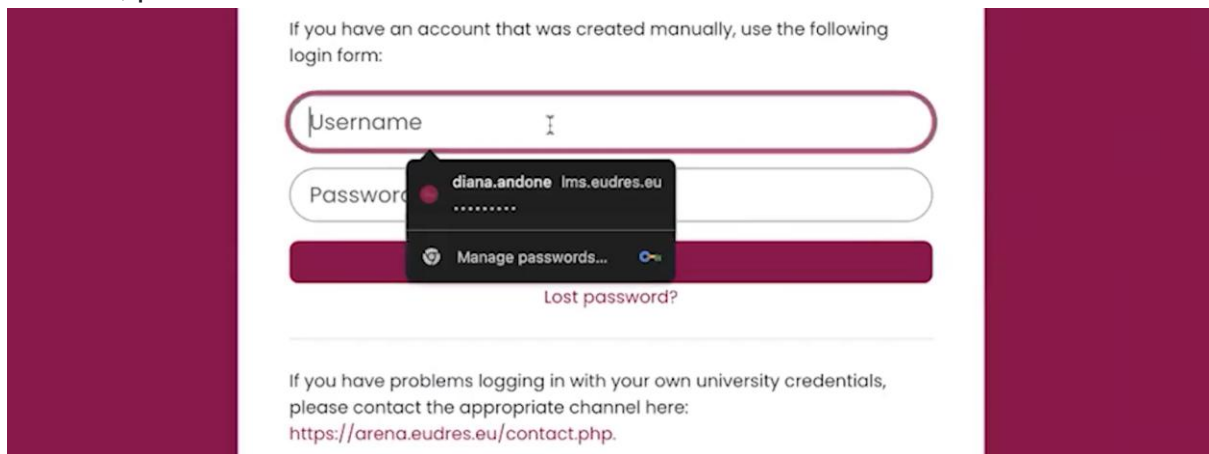
