The E³UDRES² Live Lecture Days is a **2-day event with continuous presentations from all E³UDRES² partners**. We're inviting **passionate and innovative lecturers to take part** with their own lecture, providing engaging knowledge to a community of 100.000+ students!

How the Live Lecture Days work

Participating lecturers give 40–50 min online lectures back-to-back, followed by **5–15 minutes of Q&A**, to an international audience of students, researchers, staff and other E³UDRES² stakeholders. Viewers can choose which lecturers they want to join and can digitally register for the lectures they are interested in beforehand. The lectures will be organized as **MS Teams webinars by the E³UDRES² Head Office**.

Your mission is to ignite curiosity and connection across Europe with an online lecture by creating an engaging session around one of our core E³UDRES² themes (more information about the Focus Areas: <https://eudres.eu/what-we-do>):

1. Health, Wellbeing and Social Inclusion for Regions
2. Digital Solutions and (Applied) Deep Tech for Regions
3. Resilient Economy and Innovation for Regions
4. Creative Industries for Region's Identity

All sessions must be held **in English**, ideally using **interactive tools** (such as polls, collaborative platforms, mini-challenges or quizzes), and aim to maximize student participation and motivation.

Participating lecturers will receive:

- An official Certificate of Participation
- Visibility across a European network
- A course in the Arena Learning Hub – a E³UDRES² platform
- The opportunity to inspire and connect with international students and experts

How to participate

Submit the **E³UDRES² Live Lecture Days – Speaker Application Form**:

All submitted proposals will be carefully reviewed by the E³UDRES² team. If you are selected, you will be contacted soon to discuss the details. Formatting and technical recommendations for preparing presentations will be available in the Learning Hub course.

The organizers of the Live Lecture Days will provide a preparatory session to ensure that all technical aspects run smoothly on the day of the event.
